
DELECTABLE DISCOVERIES IN GREENSBORO



GREENSBORO'S GARMENT LEGACY


Greensboro, sometimes referred to as Jeansboro, is the world capital of denim, celebrating this legacy for its third consecutive century. For more than 127 years, Greensboro has been home to textile mills and apparel factories, which were the largest of their kind for the majority of the 20th Century. The first yard of denim cloth was woven in 1896, and the first overalls were produced here the following year. Today, Greensboro is still called home by two of the largest denim brands, Lee and Wrangler, and their parent business, Kontoor Brands. Greensboro also remains the home of Cone Denim and Burlington, two of the largest manufacturers of denim cloth in the world. During World War II, Cone Export & Commission Company leased a large tract of land to the U.S. Army for \$1 per year. It would host the Overseas Replacement Depot and Basic Training Camp No. 10, housing an average of 35,000 troops in our city daily throughout the war and facilitated by our train station downtown. While the factories in downtown made uniforms for GIs and the mills. churned out cloth destined for overseas, Greensboro was the only city with a basic training camp located within its city limits.





Greensboro's economic prosperity and rich history is intrinsically tied to jeans, and three centuries later, it's still in our genes. Today, the revitalization effort at the three remaining mills in the newly named Mill District, located in NE Greensboro, is breathing new life into these gigantic structures, creating hundreds, if not thousands of homes for residents and businesses. The community made prowess of industry possible. Philanthropic efforts from the families that led these great businesses are visible throughout the city today, from parks to theaters and countless grants awarded to worthy organizations. Greensboro is the city that made Levi Strauss famous for its sturdy cloth, the city that won the hearts of cowboys everywhere with Blue Bell's Wrangler, and the city where we all remain cut from the same cloth today!



AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY

From the beginning of our nation's history to today, African Americans have been instrumental in creating the world around us. There is no denying Greensboro's roots in African American history run deep, and one institution, the Charlotte Hawkins Brown Museum at Historic Palmer Memorial Institute, discusses just that.

The museum interprets the life and work of Dr. Charlotte Hawkins Brown - a prominent NC-born educator and advocate for social justice - and her school, Palmer Memorial Institute. From 1902 to 1971, Palmer served as the premiere college preparatory and social finishing school for the black middle class and graduated several significant figures in our state's history. Visitors can explore the school's campus, uncover connections between Dr. Brown and the Civil Rights Movement, and discover how African Americans lived in the south during the Jim Crow Era. THE HISTORIC MAGNOLIA HOUSE

During segregation, The Historic Magnolia House, formerly known as Magnolia House Motel and Daniel D. Debutts House, accommodated traveling African Americans who were not allowed to share the same facilities as Caucasians. The property was recognized as a highly recommended place to stay in six editions of The Green Book. The Historic Magnolia

House hosted many famous guests including Rav Charles, Jackie Robinson, Ike and Tina Turner, Louis Armstrong, James Brown, and James Baldwin. Today, the Historic Magnolia House, listed on the National Register of Historic Places, is one of very few Green Book sites continuing to operate within their historic context. The Downtown Greenway, a collaborative project between the City of Greensboro and Action Greensboro, is a 4-mile walking and biking trail that encourages economic development, increases the city's tax base, and improves quality of life for citizens and visitors. This urban loop around the center city of downtown Greensboro enhances the urban landscape with a green space that promotes fitness, connectedness, and wellbeing in an aesthetically pleasing environment.

With its emphasis on public art, the Greenway tells stories and engages trail users in unique and authentic ways. With the connections to the extensive existing and planned trails system in the city and the county, this loop is the hub of the entire system, connecting residents from all parts of the community and beyond. With three miles built and open to the public, and the final mile to go under construction this year, the Downtown Greenway is expected to be completed in 2025.
